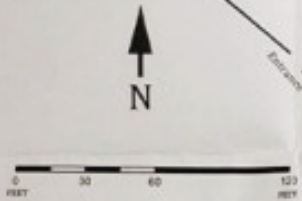


WESTERN STATE HOSPITAL HISTORIC PATIENT CEMETERY 1879 to 1953

Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this map. However, be aware that it has been developed using both GIS mapping data, in addition to historical records. Therefore, all original markers are not present, due to deterioration and neglect. If you need further assistance in locating a relative, please contact Grave Concerns Association; contact information can be found on the reverse side of this map.
